Despite their lower number of suicide deaths each year, older adults consistently have the highest yearly rate of suicide deaths. This webinar will present the latest understanding of the dynamics of suicide and how these dynamics play out in suicide ideation and behavior in older adults versus other age groups. Finally, the presentation will present interventions that may be effective to prevent suicidal ideation and behaviors in older adults living in both the community and congregate care. Finally, we'll explore the effect of COVID in suicide prevention and older adults. The last portion of the webinar will be interactive with a discussion of how the information relates to participants' practice with older adults.
